

Celebration of the IEA 60th Anniversary

This year, IEA, the global Federation of Human Factors and Ergonomics Societies, is celebrating its sixtieth anniversary. Founded in 1959 as a society of individuals, IEA today covers 53 societies from all over the globe. IEA collaborates with our networks as well as individual member societies to promote HFE on the global scale.

The most visible activity is the IEA congress, that is held every three years. Next, many activities are undertaken to meet the interest of ergonomists and human factors specialists, so that they can perform best to improve human performances in the world, while taking care for the health, safety and well-being of workers and users of products. IEA collaborates with international bodies, for instance with ILO in the realization of human factors and ergonomics guidelines, and in developing a vision on the Future of Work, with the World Health Organization and ISQUA IEA works on Patient Safety practices for integrating human factors in the promotion of quality and safety in healthcare worldwide.



Other activities focus on professional standards and the promotion of the discipline. IEA Technical Committees professionals worldwide collaborate to develop new knowledge, methods and solutions. In sixty years IEA has grown from a small group of individuals, who discussed their interests, into a powerful umbrella under which more than twenty thousand highly competent professionals work together for a better world.

Professional Education and Standards Workshop of Asian Ergonomics Societies

Representatives of Ergonomics Societies from Korea, Japan, Singapore, the Philippines, Malaysia, Indonesia, India, Thailand and Taiwan came together at Taipei, Taiwan on the 16th and 17th of March, 2019 for a workshop on Professional Education and Standards under the aegis of the Asian Council of Ergonomics and Design (ACED). An observer from Brunei also attended the workshop, which was superbly hosted by the Ergonomics Society of Taiwan (EST).

The objectives of the workshop were to acquire knowledge about the current policies, programs and strategies for ergonomics educational systems in the different countries, to share best practices with institutions both at public and private level that are supporting educational institutions in establishing quality 'human-in-loop' management systems and practices, and to expand the opportunities for cooperation, networking and learning among institutions in the Asia Pacific region.

Each country representative reported on the Ergonomics education framework / model of their country, highlighting the current strengths, weaknesses, limitations and opportunities. President of ISE, Dr. Anindya K. Ganguli, presented a detailed report on Ergonomics Education in India.



An amalgamated list of fundamental competencies necessary for an ergonomic education program was compiled, based on the different education programmes in each country and the three core competencies of HFE (Physical, Cognitive and Organizational ergonomics).

It was concluded that ergonomics education systems can be reformed to solve problems that are detected through learning assessments. A framework or model for ergonomics education system to solve the problems in applications through learning processes was proposed.

On the last day, the EST arranged for a tour of the Xinbeitou hot spring zone.
