

# The upright seated posture revisited

This 90-90-90 posture rule just won't die! Conventional Wisdom tells us this is the one correct way to work. Current ergonomics thinking, however, says that this is a wrong, or too narrow a recommendation. Furthermore, we rarely see people voluntarily sitting this way unless they consciously hold this rigid posture or there is another ergonomic issue leading them to do so (such as keyboard or monitor too high).



The human body does not like static rigid postures - it likes variety, variation and some movement. This upright seated position with the hips at 90 actually flattens the normal curve in the low back and results in increased strain.

At a presentation in Minneapolis, USA, Tom Albin (Engineer, Certified Ergonomist, consultant, and Director of the Office Ergonomics Research Consortium), told the group that this 90-90-90 posture came to prominence by accident. He told the attendees that the earlier version of the ANSI/HFES 100-2007 Human Factors Engineering Standard for Computer Workstations had used a 90-90-90 drawing on the cover of the final standard.

People who read no further than the cover incorrectly assumed that this was the correct way to sit when operating a computer! The actual standard recommendations included several reference postures including: Reclined seated, Upright seated, Thighs declined, and Standing. # What are the recommendations for seated computer work?

- ✓ Regularly move and change positions
- ✓ Reduce lumbar strain with an open hip angle greater than 90 degrees. Reclining against the back rest opens the hip angle and restores the normal curve in the spine while also shifting much of the upper body weight onto the backrest and further reducing spinal loading. (Reclining beyond a 120-130 degree back angle can result in significant neck flexion when viewing the monitor, however.)
- ✓ Sitting upright with declined thighs (tilt seat down in front) also results in a more normal lumbar curve and significant reductions in spinal disc pressure.

# How do we enable this healthy seated posture?

- ✓ Increase awareness of good postures and the risks of awkward ones.
- ✓ Modify the work system (chair, monitor, input devices etc.) to enable a range of healthy postures.
- ✓ Teach the user how to make the available adjustments.
